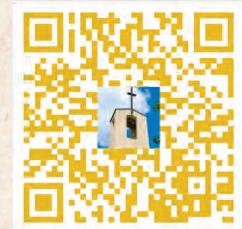

“Deliver Us” Week 2: Not By Bread Alone

In this first summer series, we are looking at ways that God delivers us. We’re specifically looking at the first reading at Mass each week through the lens of the Exodus story, and how ultimately God’s promises are fulfilled in Jesus Christ.

Today on this feast day, we celebrate God’s provision in the Most Holy Eucharist. In today’s first reading from **Deuteronomy 8:1-16**, Moses reminds the people of the long journey they’ve been on. In this last testament before they enter the Promised Land, he reminds them not to forget how even in his allowing them to be afflicted, he elected them as his chosen people, and he provided for them all long.

We are reminded that life is a long journey and there are many tests and afflictions, but to not forget about God’s great provision for us on our journey. He provides for us in countless ways – our health, our family, our gifts and talents, our education, our work, our country; and today we celebrate how God provides for us in the great gift of the Eucharist.

- Each year at St. John’s on the Feast of Corpus Christi, we launch an ancient parish tradition called “**40 Hours.**” From **Sunday June 7 at 7 pm to Tuesday June 9 at 12 noon**, the church will be open for personal prayer before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.
