#### 2026-2027 Pilot

Our first pilot will run from April 2026 -June 2027 with breaks in December and July. We plan to have five weekend (Friday/Saturday) retreats, potentially in May, September, February, April, and June. Alongside these will be monthly online huddles for the lead pastors.

#### **Participants**

At least three leaders from each participating church, including the lead pastor. Larger teams are welcome.

#### Retreats

Retreats will include a mixture of teaching and training, interacting with members of your team in guided settings, and engaging with other church teams on the same journey.

#### Cost

The 2026-2027 pilot will run at **half price**, with a cost of \$2,000 for a team of three and \$500 per additional person.
