Love Leader 101 empowers New Yorkers with tools to identify, respond to and prevent relational violence, break cycles of harm, and build healthy relationships.

WHY THIS MATTERS

- Domestic violence doesn't just hurt people; it drains communities. Domestic violence is a public health crisis in NYC, with over 42,550 cases reported in the first half of 2024; disproportionately affecting Black and Latina residents.
- As survivors themselves, our founders created the program they once needed: practical, healing-centered support that transforms individuals and strengthens communities. They now return to communities; where trauma runs deep but healing is possible.

THE SOCIAL RETURN

For every **\$7K** invested in a Love Leader participant:

- Violence is prevented before it escalates. Generational trauma is disrupted
- Residents become community wellness responders
- Demand for emergency services declines

THE FINANCIAL IMPACT

- One domestic violence emergency response, including police, ER visits, legal aid, homeless and child welfare services, can cost the city up to \$35,000.
- Love Leader 101 delivers long-term prevention and healing for a fraction of that cost.

- Participants rebuild trust and model healthy love in their communities.
- Communities shift from crisis to resilience-saving thousands in public service costs.
